colourWOOD pre-coated panellings are available in two finishes

Lacquers - Vacuum Coated and U.V. Cured (v.c.u.v.) – for weather protected areas

A more robust finish and extremely versatile. Lacquers are suitable as a finish to ALL internal (and fully protected external) surfaces (walls, ceilings, soffits.) They would normally be preferred where internal panelling is subject to surface contact and wear – e.g. passageways, stairwells and family rooms.

Penetrating Oils – suitable for both weather protected and weather exposed areas

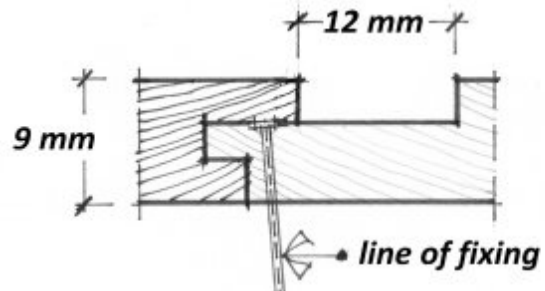
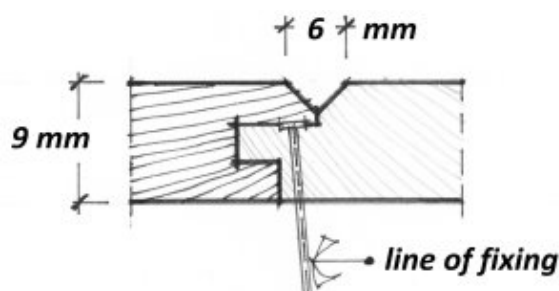
A more natural looking finish – easily maintained and recoated – ideal for ceilings, soffits and internal wall finishes to more formal areas where human contact is negligible.

With penetrating oils, subsequent on-site coats should they be required for colour intensity are much easier to apply over a pre-applied first coat.

VEE JOINT - 86 & 137 cover x 9 mm thick

SHIPLAP – 86 & 137 cover x 9 mm thick



9mm profiles will span 600 mm when fixed to studs or noggings as a wall panelling and 450 mm when fixed to the underside of rafters or purlins as a ceiling or soffit lining - refer to the web site for more comprehensive specification and details -

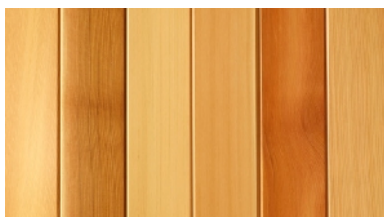

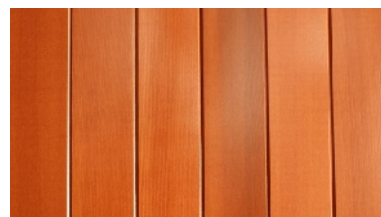
Lacquer (v.c.u.v.) - images on Western Red Cedar



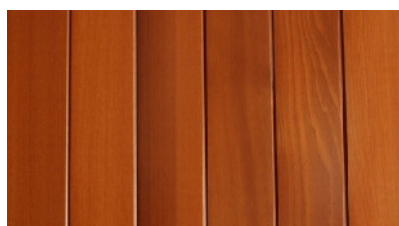

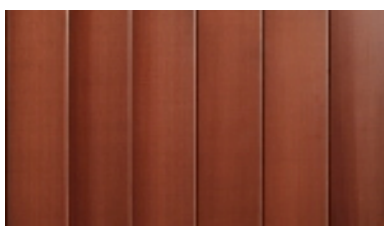

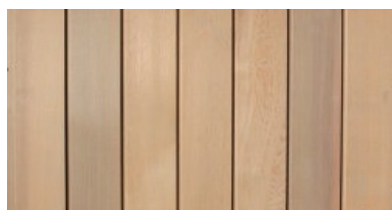
The application of our Lacquers starts with a finely sanded panelling board. An initial sealer coat is applied to face, back and edges in one application. This is then dried and the board is again fine sanded. The final coat is then applied, again all round, and the product is then U.V. cured.

Cutek CD50 Penetrating Oil - images on Western Red Cedar

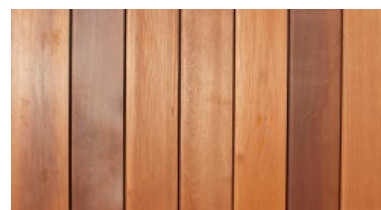
Cutek CD50 displays a natural looking matt finish – all colours allow natural grain patterns to show through



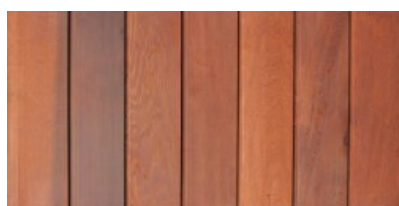

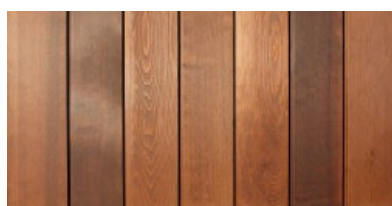

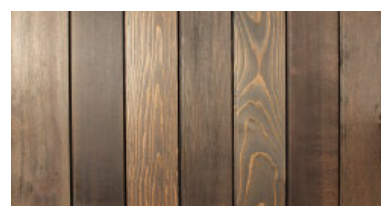
